

The Strongsville Rotary Foundation is soliciting nominations for this year's Harry Fuehrer Community Service Award.

The Award. The Harry Fuehrer Annual Community Service Award recognizes an individual or couple who has/have provided exemplary community service to Strongsville over an extended period.

Nominations for each year's recipient are made by members of the Rotary Club of Strongsville, and the recipient(s) selected by the Strongsville Rotary Foundation Board of Trustees.

Who is eligible? Although the award *emphasizes* exemplary service by a community member who is not a member of the Rotary Club of Strongsville, club members may be nominated and considered for selection based on their community service **NOT** related to Rotary activities. To be considered, nominees must live, work or volunteer in Strongsville.

History. The Harry Fuehrer Community Service Award was created shortly after the untimely death of Harry Fuehrer, the first president of the Rotary Club of Strongsville. Harry had been the president of Rotary Club of West Lafayette, Indiana before moving to Strongsville. Harry was a great leader and knew how to organize members into an enthusiastic and cohesive group. Harry truly embodied the Rotary motto of "Service Above Self," and he touched and enriched the lives of those who knew him. The Harry Fuehrer Fellowship, recognizing contributions of \$1000 or more to the Strongsville Rotary Foundation, also was named in his honor.
